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# European Directive on the interoperability of electronic road toll systems

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The road to full interoperability?







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/ 01 THE NEW EUROPEAN DIRECTIVE

Directive 2019/520 published in JOUE

Implementation and
Delegation acts
(regulations) to be
adopt by the EU
within 6 months

Member States have now 30 months to make Directive's transposition

## Technologies for new electronic toll roads with OBE

Procedures for registering EETS providers with specific requirements

Rights and Obligations of EETS providers

- / Satellite positioning
- / Mobile communications
- / 5,8 GHz DSRC

/ Must cover all domains in 4 Member States within 3 years

## Rights and Obligations of Toll Chargers

- / Ensure EETS interoperability of the toll systems
- / Publish toll domain statements conditions
- / Non discrimination
- / Contract and invoice flexibility
- / Substantially modified electronic road toll system
- / Rebates and discounts to promote electronic toll payments

Remuneration

/ Transparent and non discriminatory



#### / 02 WHAT'S NEW

#### **Tolls**

/ Toll Charger vehicle classification prevails

/ EETS provider not liable if OBE list was published

#### **Accounting**

/ Separate accounts for each service (EETS)

/ Cross subsidies not allowed

## Rights and Obligations of EETS Users

/ May subscribe to any EETS provider

/ Responsible to use only one OBE if several are installed in a vehicle

## Conciliation Body

/ Independent CB designated by the Member State

/ Responsible for mediation with specific rules between TC and EETS providers



#### / 02 WHAT'S NEW

#### **Technical provisions**

/ EETS provider must provide traffic data of their clients

/ 5 years for Back-Office interfaces compliant

## Interoperability Constituents

- / Toll Charger to publish conformity information on new systems
- / Accreditation and test environment

## Exchange of Information on failure to pay road fees

- / Cross-border enforcement applies to all kinds of tolling (time-based, all vehicles)
- / Supported on already existing services
- / To provide data related to the vehicle and the owner or holder
- / Strong focus on data protection



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

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#### **CHALLENGES**

# NEW DIRECTIVE brings new tools, But we still have to:

Change protocols with Public Authorities

Make transposition (30 months)

Assure, in case of non voluntary payment of the notification, automatic execution of the debt in the destination country

Adjust national enforcement laws to new terms (foreigners)

Negotiate new deals with EETS Providers
