The user pays and polluter pays principles will be part of the future EU policy. To meet these objectives a proper, harmonized tolling/charging scheme is needed in EU. To this end EU Institutions, states and stakeholders examine both EC proposals regarding EETS and Eurovignette. When finally adopted, they will be part of a realistic tolling policy in EU where the Toll Chargers and the Service providers will provide realistic tolling services to citizens/users in the various EU regions under realistic commercial conditions. In the discussion will appear that Tolling is the fairest and the most sustainable way to develop new roads and to manage and maintain existing ones.
