# Launch of the REETS project

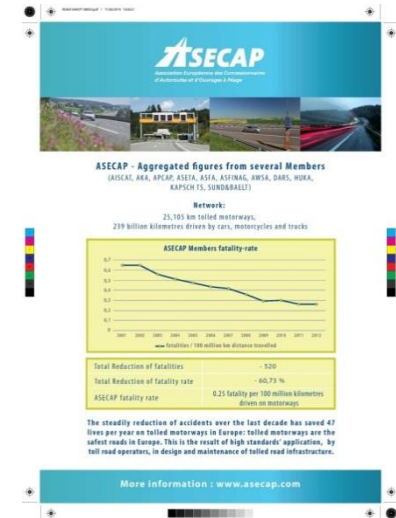
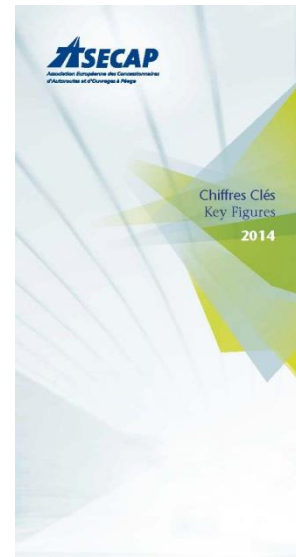
- Proposal made under Klaus Schierhackl ASECAP presidency
- Project accepted by the European Commission
- Aim of the project : define what could be done to implement a Regional European Electronic Toll service (REETS) as a first step to EETS
- Start of the project – septembre 2013
- Duration : 18 months
