


From REETS to an EETS Facilitation Platform

REETS is a success story




- REETS has achieved its objectives
 - ✓ Analytical Activities 1 5 completed
 - ✓ Info platform in operation
 - Cross border implementations started and will continue
- We have triggered a huge change process which is constantly evolving
 - First TC/SP implementations will come in operation in 2016
 - 3 implementing EETS Providers (Axxès, Telepass and Total) + several implementing Service Providers – others likely to follow
 - The REETS community will constantly move towards EETS (horizon 2017/2018)
- Transition of the project to an EETS Facilitation Platform

MoU for an EETS Facilitation Platform (EFP)





- 2 key elements of the EFP
 - EETS Information Platform: managed by ASECAP and AETIS
 - EETS Facilitation Platform: managed by a Secretariat (ASFINAG)
- Signing parties
 - Toll Charger and EETS Provider / Service Provider
 - Member States (not acting as TC) as observers
 - ASECAP and AETIS
- EETS Steering Group (ESG): strategic guidance
- EETS Working Group: coordination of operational cross border deployment activities






Conclusions and future Key Issues



- EETS Market develops: New Players come, others leave
- The REETS Community found together let us grow it!
 - CZ, PT, SI, BE,
 - Via Verde, T-Systems
- Accept and foster interim solutions towards EETS (e.g. more than just one EETS-OBU for a certain period).
 - → Not waiting for the perfect (technical) solution, just do it based on solutions available

Conclusions and future Key Issues



- Fair and effective Competition
 - Effective competition necessary for future prices of the service
 - → Regional Providers will be of significant importance
 - Requirement of pan-European coverage does not fit into the market approach
 - → Look for solutions in other sectors, e.g. deregulation in airline industry or telecom (universal service)
 - Implementation and certification schedules influence time to market

Conclusions and future Key Issues



- Amendment of the regulatory framework is necessary:
 - Pan-European coverage and time limit (24 months)
 - Remuneration
 - One EETS-OBU as a criterion for registration (stepwise process)
 - Not sufficient standards / models e.g. for GNSS-systems
 - EETS for private cars?
- Let us continue and move constantly forward
